An outstanding individual board member is an effective individual contributor, but he or she also contributes to the performance of the entire board team. Strong board leaders can catalyze outstanding performance by the group, allowing the board-and the organization-to soar. They also create the conditions for a resilient board-one that can effectively govern during crisis.

A committee of seasoned nonprofit professionals searched best practices across the country and interviewed some of our region's most outstanding leaders to distill the key characteristics of people who consistently move their boards to higher levels of performance, achievement, and governance. The result is a truly advanced course outlining and nurturing the competencies that were identified. This course goes beyond the usual orientation to board roles and responsibilities to discuss adaptive leadership, generative governance, leading change, and effective partnerships between board members and with the organization's CEO.

In two half-day course sessions, participants will explore a variety of leadership challenges. The sessions will cover the context of leadership; elements of effective board leadership; leading through difficult times; and the application of concepts to participants' specific leadership work in the community.

Course sessions will be reinforced with reading assignments. This program is designed for people who have at least three years experience on a nonprofit board, have taken a leadership role on a board, and have completed basic board training courses. A desire to be more engaged, intentional, and effective as a board member is also essential.
